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














Glazes can be applied to ware in a variety of ways: brushing, dipping, and spraying being the most noteable. All glazes found in this brochure are brushing glazes. Some are available in dipping buckets, as noted on the product page, and all glazes safe for spray application are marked with the appropriate icon (found in the Icon Key on the inside cover). All glazes should be applied based on manufacturer's instructions as described on the individual product's label.

NOTE: Unless otherwise noted, all attractor pieces in this book were glazed according to manufacturer's instructions or by the suggested layering instructions below.

what is UNDERGLAZE?

Underglaze is a liquid clay with colorants added to it. Since they are made of the same materials as clay, underglazes do not melt like glaze and remain in place when fired. Underglazes (also called slips or engobes) can be applied to unfired clay (greenware) or bisqueware. When applied according to the manufacturer's directions, underglazes are opaque and can be used for detailed imagery. Underglazes require a food safe approved clear glaze applied and fired over them to become food-safe.

the underglaze ADVANTAGE

Underglazes are perfect for adding a wide range of colored detail to your work at any cone. While some colors will shift at hotter temperatures, underglazes are designed for Cone 05 all the way to Cone 10 ceramics. They can be used for everything from graphic illustrations to realistic detailing. Because they don't run or move during firing, underglazes are ideal for sgraffito, mishima, printing techniques such as stamping and screenprinting, and surface treatments like staining.





defining **GLAZE**

Glaze is a combination of minerals similar in composition to clay that when fired melt into a hard, glass-like surface that helps seal the clay. Some glazes are meant to be decorative, some are meant to be functional. Glaze can be applied a number of ways including brushing, dipping, and spraying and must be fired in a kiln to the appropriate temperature. Glaze is typically applied to bisqueware, although it can be applied to greenware (unfired ware) in some circumstances. Unlike underglazes, glazes melt and can flow when fired, making them less ideal for detail work.

what is LOW-FIRE GLAZE?

AMACO low-fire glazes are formulated to be fired at Cone 05 (around 1885°F to 1915°F). Low-fire glazes are called such because they have a low melting point compared to stoneware or porcelain clays and glazes.

the low-fire **ADVANTAGE**

AMACO low-fire glazes provide a wide variety of finishes, colors, and translucencies. As many minerals or colorants may burn or flux out at higher temperatures, low-fire glazes provide a wider, more vibrant range of colors than traditionally found in high-fire lines. Additionally, while not as unmoving as underglazes, several of AMACO's low-fire glaze lines (including Teacher's Choice and Teacher's Pallette) remain stiff enough during firing to be used similarly to paint, making them ideal for classrooms, especially introductory ceramic classes.

defining GLAZE

Glaze is a combination of minerals similar in composition to clay that when fired melt into a hard, glass-like surface that helps seal the clay. Some glazes are meant to be decorative, some are meant to be functional. Glaze can be applied a number of ways including brushing, dipping, and spraying and must be fired in a kiln to the appropriate temperature. Usually, glaze is applied to bisqueware. Unlike underglazes, glazes melt and can flow when fired, making them less ideal for detail work.

what is MID-FIRE GLAZE?

AMACO mid-fire glazes are formulated to be fired between Cone 5 and Cone 6 (around 2167°F to 2269°F) but some, such as our Celadon glazes, will fire as high as Cone 10 (around 2381°F).

the high-fire **ADVANTAGE**

AMACO mid-fire glazes provide a wide variety of finishes, colors, and translucencies. They yield similar results to Cone 10 ceramic ware without the added expense or damage to your equipment. Mid- and high-fire ware is more vitreous, meaning fired pieces are more impervious to water and made to withstand wear and tear. Several of AMACO's mid-fire lines (including Potter's Choice, Shinos, and Celadons) are formulated to imitate traditional glazes and are ideal for layering, opening a world of countless, unique combinations.


